ANNUAL EEO REPORT POSTING DEADLINES

December 1, 2021 – All Stations in Alabama, Georgia, Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, Vermont, Colorado, Minnesota, Montana, North Dakota, and South Dakota (that are part of a Station Employment Unit with five or more full-time employees): Place an annual EEO Public File Report in their public file, covering the period of December 1, 2020 – November 30, 2021. This report is placed in the public file annually on the anniversary of the deadline for filing their station's license renewal application.

February 1, 2022 – All Stations in Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Kansas, Nebraska, Oklahoma, New Jersey, New York (that are part of a Station Employment Unit with five or more full-time employees): Place an annual EEO Public File Report in their public file, covering the period of February 1, 2021 – January 31, 2022. This report is placed in the public file annually on the anniversary of the deadline for filing their station's license renewal application.

April 1, 2022 – All Stations in Texas, Indiana, Kentucky, Tennessee, Delaware, Pennsylvania, and Tennessee (that are part of a Station Employment Unit with five or more full-time employees): Place an annual EEO Public File Report in their public file, covering the period of April 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022. This report is placed in the public file annually on the anniversary of the deadline for filing their station's license renewal application.

June 1, 2022 – All Stations in Arizona, Idaho, Michigan, Nevada, New Mexico, Ohio, Utah, and Wyoming (that are part of a Station Employment Unit with five or more full-time employees): Place an annual EEO Public File Report in their public file, covering the period of June 1, 2021 to May 31, 2022. This report is placed in the public file annually on the anniversary of the deadline for filing their station's license renewal application.

August 1, 2022 – All Stations in California, Illinois and Wisconsin (that are part of a Station Employment Unit with five or more full-time employees): Place an annual EEO Public File Report in their public file, covering the period of August 1, 2021 to July 31, 2022. This report is placed in the Online Public File on the anniversary of the deadline for filing their station's license renewal application.

October 3, 2022 – All Stations in Florida, Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands, Alaska, American Samoa, Guam, Hawaii, Iowa, Marianas Islands, Missouri, Oregon, and Washington (that are part of a Station Employment Unit with five or more full-time employees): Place an annual EEO Public File Report in their public file, covering the period of October 1, 2022 – September 30, 2022. This report is placed in the public file annually on the anniversary of the deadline for filing their station's license renewal application.
