## **TOWER LIGHTING OUTAGES**

If a tower light goes out, you need to call the FAA Flight Service at 877-487-6867 to provide a NOTAM ("Notices to Airmen"). This provides notice to pilots that a tower light is not operating properly.

- 1. Call the national number 877-487-6867
- 2. The answer will say "welcome to Lockheed-Martin etc.", then will give a verbal choice of about 4 items to reply to. The choice is to say "NOTAM".
- 3. Then after that choice, the next answer will say "What state are you departing from?" - now, we know we are not departing, but you have to say the state where the tower light outage is occurring.
- 4. After you give the name of your state, the voice will say please stand by for the next available Flight Briefer and a Flight Specialist will help you.
- 5. Then you may have to wait,

Answer all questions asked by the Flight Specialist. Provide the following information:

- Call Letters of the Station
- The Tower Registration Number of the tower.
- Tell them that the Tower Lights are out on the tower.
- Tell them your name or your initials if they ask.
- Write down on the transmitter log the initials of the person you spoke with also the NOTAM number that they provide you on the phone.
- Note the Expiration Date of the NOTAM
- Post this on the Operating Logs daily.

Make a notation of the light outage in the Station's logs.

When the light is restored, make a notation in the station's log.
